



## Use of KCC Nets During Covid-19

- Facilities to be used by members only.
- Junior members must have an adult member of their household or parent/legal carer present, at all times.
- All must observe the social distancing guidelines, which are displayed at the ground.
- All members must wash/sanitise their hands before entering the site and after leaving. Members are responsible for providing the means to do so.
- Upon arrival, members must report to the supervising individual.
- Sessions will be 50 minutes in length. Please arrive on time to minimise contact with members using the nets before you, and to ensure that you are able to use the nets for a full 50 minutes. Sessions will not be extended to accommodate late arrivals.
- A First Aid kit will be available. First Aid is to be self-administered, or, in the case of a junior member, by their adult household member/parent/legal carer. During this time, if a member removes any item from the kit, the kit will need to be disposed of and replaced before the next net session. This is an additional expense for the club, and would ask that the facility is not abused. The club reserves the right to charge a member for a replacement kit. You must advise the site supervisor at the end of the session if the kit has been accessed.
- Upon your session ending, you must vacate the grounds immediately. There is to be no socialising between sessions on club grounds.
- All members are to use their own kit.
- The clubhouse and all facilities within it remain closed, including toilets.
- Bring your own drinks and ensure that you take any bottle(s)/litter/food wrappers with you upon leaving.
- Any items left at the nets will be disposed of before the next session begins, irrespective of value.
- It is member responsibility, or supervising household member/parent/legal carer, to follow net procedures. Full information is available from the ECB website. If any practice takes place that causes injury, damage or disturbance, the club will not accept any liability or responsibility whatsoever.
- The club can close the net facility at any time.

**OUTSIDE OF SUPERVISED SESSIONS, THE GROUND AND ALL FACILITIES WILL REMAIN CLOSED AND NETS CANNOT BE USED.**
